## **ARTICLE X -MISCELLANEOUS**

Section 1. These By-laws may be amended by two-thirds vote of the members present and voting at a regular business meeting held subsequent to a regular business meeting at which a resolution in writing providing for such amendment shall have been given to the members in writing or in the Council publication at least five days prior to the second meeting.

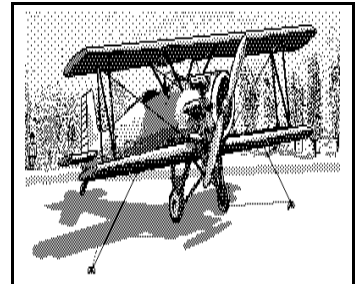

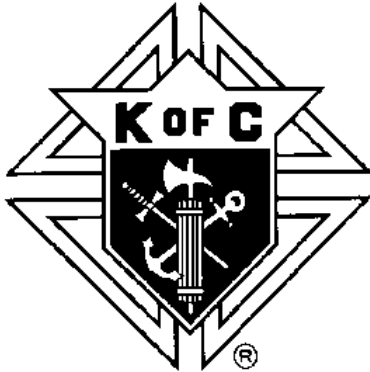
