History: The Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Program began in 1960 as a project of the Knights of Columbus Columbian Squires of North America to honor the Blessed Virgin under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. The program has continued since then as a project in several Knights of Columbus jurisdictions. Each year, a Silver Rose "honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe and reaffirming our commitment to the sanctity of human life" is carried by Knights from Canada, through the United States, and into Mexico to arrive at the Basilica in Monterrey, Mexico on December 12, Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

This year, three Silver Roses will travel from Canada to Mexico. One of the Silver Roses is expected to arrive in Maryland from West Virginia on July 19, 2010, and remain in Maryland for three weeks, until August 8, 2010, when it will be delivered to Knights in Virginia. Knights of Columbus Councils and Fourth Degree Assemblies will host a Silver Rose Prayer Service on each of the 21 days the Silver Rose will be in Maryland.
